

Communicable Disease Investigations



In order to prevent the spread of communicable diseases, New Jersey laws (N.J.A.C. Title 8, Chapter 57) provide for regulatory control through the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services. Some diseases are reportable to the state while others are reportable to the local health department. By using the Communicable Disease Reporting and Surveillance System (CDRSS), the Lyndhurst Health Department tracks diseases in order to protect the public health.
