



Dog and Cat Licenses



All cats and dogs residing in Lyndhurst must be licensed.
Licenses must be renewed every January before February 1st.

Licensing requirements:

Completed application with required fee
Proof of rabies shot (must not expire before Nov. 1st of the year).

Licensing fees:

Dogs:

Not fixed: \$15.00

Fixed: \$10.00

Owner is a Senior/dog is fixed: \$5.00

Cats:

Not fixed: \$ 10.00

Fixed: \$ 5.00

Owner is a senior/cat is fixed: \$ 3.00

Late fees: A late fee of \$10.00 is required if licensing your pet after January 31st (unless this is a new pet or you just moved in to Lyndhurst).

Licensing Methods:

In-person:

Licensing is available year round at the Lyndhurst Health Department during regular working hours (M-F 9:00 am to 4:30 pm). Licensing is also available in-person at the two rabies shot clinics held in the evening during January.

By Mail:

Mail the application, correct fee (see above), and proof of the animal's rabies shot which must not expire before Nov. 1st of the year.
